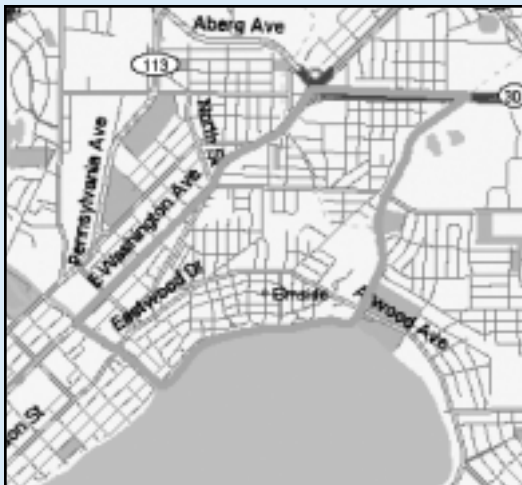

SASY has worked on a variety of projects to better our neighborhood. A few of our efforts have included:
