



## The Goodman Community Center's Goodman Gallery

The Goodman Gallery inside the Goodman Community Center displays work by contemporary artists with a tie to Madison. Are you an artist? Consider submitting your work for exhibition. Are you a community member with an interest in the arts? You might enjoy serving on the Goodman Gallery Board, a volunteer committee charged with selecting artists and promoting their shows at the Goodman Gallery.

### Submission Guidelines for the Goodman Gallery

*Who is eligible:* Contemporary artists with a cohesive body of work and a tie to Madison. Individuals and groups are invited to apply.

*How presenting artists are selected:* All submissions are reviewed by the Goodman Gallery Board, which makes its selection based on the quality of work and its thematic relationship to the community served by the Goodman Community Center.

*Requirements and benefits:* Artists must provide framed 2-dimensional works ready to hang with wire. Shows are typically scheduled for one to two months. Announcements in the *EastSideNews* and other local media publicize each show. Artists have the opportunity to sell artwork. Exhibiting artists may host an Opening event; this is optional and at the artist's own expense. At this time, only 2-D work will be considered.

All submissions must be digital in the following format: No more than 15 images, formatted as jpeg, 10 or 12 quality, no more than 900 pixels in the largest dimension, sRGB color space on CD or DVD media (CD preferred).

We do not accept submissions via e-mail. If you wish to have your disk returned, please enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope along with your submission. Evaluation and reply should take approximately 8 weeks from receipt.
