# BAR

---

We have a variety of drink packages to complement our stylish, industrial interiors and unique, affordable rooms. We can provide hosted or cash/card bars with experienced bartenders and a fully stocked bar.

Bar service is \$26 per hour, per bartender plus setup and breakdown.

Since we hold our own liquor license, all alcoholic beverages must be purchased and served through our catering team. By Wisconsin law, carry-in of any alcoholic beverage is illegal.

Outside caterers may not serve or sell alcoholic beverages at Goodman Community Center. Our hospitality team will work with event contacts for options for alcohol service. Licensed bartenders are required at all events with alcohol service, and will be GCC employees.

You are welcome to bring in your own cake or dessert and have us provide service for an additional fee. Prices below are per person.

# FAQS

---

## VENDORS:

### **Can I use my own caterer?**

Our catering is exceptional; however we do allow outside catering. For 50-99 guests, the fee is \$1.00 per person. For 100+ guests, the fee is \$3.50 per person and a licensed caterer is required.

### **Does GCC have a list of approved vendors we can use?**

We have a small list of vendors that we have worked with and love! Provided upon request.

## BAR/ALCOHOL:

### **Can I bring my own alcohol?**

No, all alcoholic beverages served or consumed on the premises must be purchased, prepared and served by the Goodman Community Center. Carry-ins are not allowed, including non-alcoholic beer.

### **Can we create signature cocktails or mix between a cash and hosted bar?**

Yes! We will work with you to customize and create the package that works best for you.

## FACILITY GUIDELINES:

### **Are candles allowed?**

Yes, provided that they are enclosed in a glass container which extends above the top of the candle flame.

### **Are dogs allowed?**

Your pups are allowed to participate in your ceremony and photos, but must go home before the reception.

### **Does GCC have liability insurance?**

Yes, we have liability insurance and you are welcome to purchase additional insurance, but it is not required.

### **How many people fit at a table?**

Our 60" rounds hold 6-8 people comfortably.

### **Does GCC have WIFI?**

Yes, we have public WIFI facility-wide.

### **Can I store my décor or rentals overnight?**

There is a \$250 overnight fee and all items must be brought to and stored in our NGL room. We will organize a pick up time on Sunday morning following the wedding. This is subject to availability.

## PARKING:

### **Is there parking available?**

We have plenty of parking! See our website for details or the tour packet map.

### **Can we leave a car overnight?**

On Friday's and Saturday you are welcome to park overnight. We just ask that the car is in either our Brassworks or Ironworks lot and is picked up the following day by noon.

## AVAILABILITY & BOOKING:

### **How do I hold my date?**

If the date is available, you will receive an facility use contract with the wedding package you have chosen. You will have 2 weeks to pay the full amount to secure your date.

### **Is there a service fee?**

Our service fee is 22% (on any food or alcohol) and Wisconsin state sales tax is 5.5%

### **What dates are available?**

Our wedding coordinator would love to talk through available dates and schedule a tour with you!

## CANCELLATION POLICY:

If you cancel more than 6 months prior to your event date, you will be refunded 80% of the room fees paid, and security/damage deposit will be refunded. If you cancel 3 to 6 months prior to the event date, you will forfeit all room fees paid (security/damage deposit will be returned). If your event is canceled less than 3 months prior to the event, no refund is given.
