Delivering the food from your food drive

We can receive donations at any time, but if you are delivering a large quantity of food from a food drive, it helps if you can deliver it directly to our gym so we don't have to move it again.

The gym will be open for donation drop-offs

- Thursday, June 28 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.
- Friday, June 29 from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Saturday, June 30 from 8:30 a.m. to noon

If you need to deliver your food before June 28, bring your donations to the front desk of the Center. Our hours are Monday-Friday, 6 a.m. to 8 p.m., Saturday and Sunday 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Money helps fill in what's needed

We will purchase fresh eggs, milk, bread and fruit weekly, so financial gifts are vital. We are able to buy in bulk at reduced prices, so financial support really strengthens our efforts. Gifts that exceed the need will support the Fritz Food Pantry and Center food programs.
